SURPRISE, Ariz. ( Feb. 14, 2005) — DMB Associates, Inc. has announced five Valley homebuilders will build in the first phase of development at Marley Park, the company's newest community coming to Surprise in Spring 2005. Randall Martin Home will also debut two home series at Marley Park: The Berkshire series, with four unique floor plans and The Townsend series, with three unique floor plans. Scott Communities is offering six floor plans within The Cedars at Marley Park.

In total, 21 distinctive builder models will be showcased at Marley Park's centralized Model Home Neighborhood. Models are scheduled for completion in Spring 2005. Homeowners can enjoy a preview of the lifestyle at Marley Park by visiting the Welcome Center, located west of the Loop 101 at 13118 Founders Park Blvd., just south of Waddell Road and east of Reems Road in Surprise.
