Prohibited Plant and Landscape Materials List

The following plant species and landscape materials are prohibited from use within Marley Park.

Juniper Trees	Juniper species <i>Exception: shrub species listed on the Approved Plant List</i>
Mulberry Tree	Morus alba
Olive Tree	Olea europaea <i>Exception: fruitless species listed on the Approved Plant List</i>
Mexican Palo Verde Tree	Parkinsonia aculeatra
Fountain Grass	Pennisetum setaccum
Buffel Grass	Pennisetum ciliare
Tamarisk or Salt Cedar	Tamarix aphylla

Prohibited Landscape Materials

- Polyethylene film or other plastic barriers under landscape areas.
- Steel, plastic, scalloped concrete or wooden headers or borders in the Front Yard Zone.
- Colored rock, gravels, decomposed granite or mineral ground cover other than those described and specifically allowed by these Guidelines.
